Requirements for application

- Must meet at least one of the following criteria;
 - ✓ have GPA 3.2 or higher.
 - ✓ Have achieved outstanding results in extracurricular activities.
 - ✓ have displayed significant dedication to community service.

*A certified copy of latest transcript, reference letter or proper support document must be attached.

- Must be at least 15 but not yet 19 years of age at the time of application.
- Must be in good mental and physical health condition.
- Must have a positive personality and have an interest in Japanese culture, custom, and cultural exchange.
- Applicant's parents and school must acknowledge the purpose of this program and agree with his/her participation.

Program Period

About two weeks beginning in late November or early December 2024

Application Period

August 1, 2024 ~ September 27, 2024

Where to stay

You will be staying in either the peaceful suburbs of <u>Kyushu area</u>, located in the southern part of Japan or Okinawa prefecture, the southernmost prefecture of Japan.

Activities

You will attend Japanese school from Mon to Fri. Observe the differences between Japanese education systems and your school. Enjoy the weekends as a member of Japanese family.

Costs covered by the scholarship

Round trip airfare from the US to Japan <u>* Meals are provided by host families. Extra</u> <u>expenses in case of eating out are excluded.</u>

Other expenses

- Traveler's insurance
- > Payment of medical costs for injury or sickness
- Other incidental costs

Required documents

- > Application form *available on our website
- Two letters of recommendation (One from your school principal and the other is from a teacher.)
- Supporting documents for the required criteria Ex: Latest transcript, recommendation letter from a coach, volunteer certificates etc.
- Letter to Japanese host family
- > A few photos of yourself and your family
- > Waiver & Release form *available on our website
- Essay: "The reason why I am a good candidate to receive this scholarship." *500 words or more
- Self introduction video We encourage you to make a <u>1 to 2 minute video</u> in your home/school environment talking about what you like to do and why you want to participate in this scholarship program. Submit your video via email.
- Passport copy
